## **Climate Leadership Plan**

BC is in the process of developing a new <u>Climate</u> <u>Leadership Plan</u> with the advice of the Climate Leadership team and through public consultation. We encourage you to participate in this important process.


There will be two opportunities to participate in shaping new climate policies in BC. First, British Columbians are invited to comment on a <u>climate discussion paper</u> that considers the ideas, values and priorities they want to see in a new plan. This discussion paper will be posted for a one month public review period between **July 17, 2015** and **August 17, 2015**.

After reviewing the feedback and recommendations received, government will release a **draft Climate Leadership Plan** in **December 2015**. British Columbians will have a chance to review the draft plan and provide comments on specific climate change policies and actions.
