CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE DEATH OF DUANE NELSON

VANCOUVER – The inquest into the death of Duane Nelson has been scheduled. Mr. Nelson was found unresponsive in cells at the Port Hardy RCMP detachment on Sept. 18, 2007. Despite medical attention, he died on Sept. 20, 2007, at Victoria General Hospital.

The inquest is scheduled for Nov. 24-28, 2008. Presiding coroner Shane DeMeyer and a jury will publicly hear evidence from subpoenaed witnesses in order to determine the facts surrounding the death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances in the future.
