**ORDER**

WHEREAS:

- On May 9, 2014 Oranya Farms II Holdings Inc. filed an appeal from the April 14, 2014 decision of the British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board to convert certified organic chicken from specialty to mainstream.
- Mr. Ansley, counsel for the appellant, confirmed the withdrawal of the appeal in a email dated December 18, 2015.
- Section 17 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, SBC 2004, c. 45 provides that if an appellant withdraws an appeal, the tribunal must order that the appeal is dismissed.

THEREFORE THIS BOARD ORDERS:

1. That the appeal filed on May 9, 2014 by Oranya Farms II Holdings Inc. from the April 14, 2014 decision of the British Columbia Chicken Marketing Board concerning the conversion of certified organic chicken from specialty to mainstream is hereby dismissed.
