1. Do you identify as Aboriginal?
2. If so, are you First Nations, Metis and/or Inuit?
3. If First Nations, are you registered under the *Indian Act of Canada*

you can:

- » Help make our programs and services better for you and your community (i.e. training partnerships, mentoring, internship programs and employment programs); and
- » Help improve the quality of life for Aboriginal Peoples.

Self identification is a **contribution** only you can make!

Self identification is **voluntary and it will not affect your eligibility** for ministry programs and services.
