Have you received a letter indicating you owe money to the Province of British Columbia?

Individuals who are no longer receiving assistance and who have:

- » received repayable hardship assistance payments,
- » received assistance payments they were not eligible for, and/or
- » received security deposit(s) or other repayable supplements while receiving assistance,

may owe funds to the Province of British Columbia.

Revenue Services of British Columbia provides debt collection on behalf of the province for individuals who are no longer receiving assistance.
