

CPP Disability
Client Information/Document Checklist

Please bring the following documents to your appointment:

- Your Social Insurance Number (SIN) – the card is not required if you know the number.
- Your birth certificate or baptismal certificate or a certified copy. This may not be required if you can provide your date of birth and SIN.
- Information on *any* child(ren) born after 1958. This includes any adult child(ren) if you had years of low earnings due to acting as the child(ren)'s primary caregiver. This information could be either:
 - their birth certificate or baptismal certificate or a certified copy; **or**
 - their date of birth and SIN.
- A void personal cheque if you would like to receive CPP benefits by direct deposit.

In addition, please be prepared to discuss:

- Your work history (including start/end dates and employers).
- Your work history in other countries and and identification number (if known).
- Disability benefits from another source (i.e., Employment Insurance; WCB; private insurance; foreign country).
- Name(s), address(es) and telephone number(s) of physician(s) you have seen in last 2 years, including primary physician.
- Information about any recent hospitalizations including the hospital name and address, the attending physician and the dates of admission and discharge.
- List of any medication you take, including dosage and frequency
