

## **CPP Early Retirement** **Client Information/Document Checklist**

**Please provide the following documents or information in advance of your appointment or bring them to your appointment:**

- Your Canada Pension Plan Statement of Contributions.
- Your Social Insurance Number (SIN) – the card is not required if you know the number.
- Your birth certificate or baptismal certificate, if available. This may not be required if you can provide your date of birth and SIN.
- Information on any child(ren) born after 1958, including any adult child(ren), if you had years of low earnings due to acting as the child(ren)'s primary caregiver. This could be either:
  - their birth certificate or baptismal certificate or a certified copy; **or**
  - their date of birth and SIN.
- A void personal cheque if you would like to receive CPP benefits by direct deposit.
