Date	Increase	Summary
24 Mar 2014	3.00%	A general wage increase of three percent (3%). This does not apply to DM's, Associate DM's or ADM's.
29 Mar 2009	2.5%	A general wage increase of two and one half percent (2.5%). This does not apply to DM's, Associate DM's or ADM's
30 Mar 2008	2.5%	A general wage increase of two and one half percent (2.5%). This does not apply to DM's, Associate DM's or ADM's
01 Apr 2007	2.5%	A general wage increase of two and one half percent (2.5%). This does not apply to DM's, Associate DM's or ADM's
12 Sept 2006	-	Introduction of the Management Classification and Compensation Framework
01 Aug 2006	-	Introduction of an Executive Compensation Plan for DM's, Associate DM's and ADM's.
02 Apr 2006	2.5%	A general wage increase of two and one half percent (2.5%). A one time payment equal to \$1.0715 per hour for current regular and auxiliary employees (as of March 31, 2006) for all hours paid at the straight time rate for the period from April 1, 2004 to and including March 31, 2006 (subject to statutory deductions), to a maximum of \$3900.
30 Mar 2003	3.2%	Cost of Living Adjustment
31 Mar 2002	2.5%	A general wage increase of two and one half (2.5) percent. Does not apply to ML 12 positions.
05 Jun 2001	-	The maximum salary rate for Deputy Ministers is increased to \$203,500. A new minimum salary rate is set at \$134,300.
01 Apr 2001	2.5%	A general wage increase of two and one half (2.5) percent to positions rated above ML1 except ML 12 (e.g., Deputy Minister). A general wage increase of \$.70 per hour to positions rated at or below ML 1.
02 Apr 2000	2.0%	A two (2.0) percent increase to all rates of pay except Deputy Ministers.
01 Jan 2000	-	The maximum salary rate for Deputy Ministers is increased to \$144,000.
01 Jan 2000	-	A lump sum payment of \$200 to full-time employees who have worked 1827 straight time hours between January 1, 1999 and December 31, 1999.
30 Nov 1997	1.0%	1% general increase including positions with a salary of \$100,000 or greater.
15 Jan 1995	1.5%	Levels 1 to 10 only. Increase does not apply to positions with a salary of \$100,000 or greater.
01 Apr 1993	2.0%	4 month delay - salary increase applied to levels which did not receive the December 6, 1992 increase (Levels 7 to 11 only). Deputy Ministers' salaries frozen.
