- ⊙ Employment surveys indicate that there is an extreme shortage of skilled trade workers and health care workers now and in the foreseeable future.
- ⊙ It is possible to meet university entrance requirements while participating in trades training programs.
- ⊙ Most trades students exceed graduation credit counts.
- ⊙ Graduates of these programs experience a seamless transition from school into the world of work.
- ⊙ Students earn graduation credits while simultaneously gaining college or university credits.

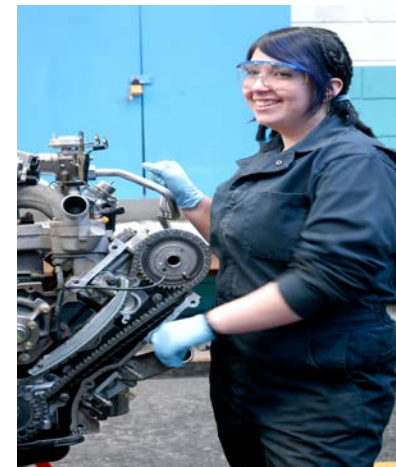

bound Student:**

1. The student satisfies graduation requirements and successfully graduates.
2. The student successfully completes "Level One" technical training.
3. The student becomes indentured as an official apprentice to a community based employer in a trade of their choice.

Trade training programs are rich in financial incentives and scholarship opportunities.

Students who successfully complete the SSA (Secondary School Apprenticeship) course may qualify for a \$1,000 Scholarship.

Possession of trades certification enhances probability of acceptance into other educational programs and opportunities.

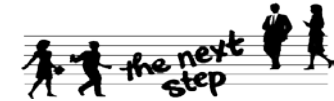
