

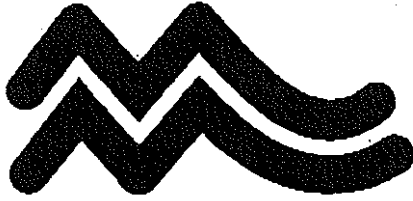
2. Please give a brief description of new initiatives implemented by school districts for French second language programs.

- Pilot the implementation of the DELF exam for Grade 6 and 7 (level A2)
- The French Federal Funding went into certifying markers and evaluators
- Provide release time for some teachers to attend DELF specific information sessions/pro-d within or outside the district
- A guest speaker (Daniel Moore) was brought in to speak about the European Framework
- We offered a French for Teachers series for the Core French staff (Grades 5-8)
- Develop and pilot an assessment tool called D.A.R.T. for kindergarten to grade two
- Develop a handbook for Core French teachers Grade 7 and Intensive French (activities and assessments)

3. Please give a brief description of planned expenditures by school districts for carried over federal funds for school year 2010/2011.

- After having piloted the DELF for Grade 6/7, it was felt that more teachers needed to be trained as evaluators/trainers. Next year, we would like to pilot the DELF for the level B1 and B2
- Continue to develop D.A.R.T. for grade three students and continue to pilot D.A.R.T. at the grades one and two
- Funds have been set aside in order to help support all our new full time kindergarten classrooms. This year we have three classes and next year we will have six classes
