3. Please give a brief description of planned expenditures by school districts for carried over federal funds for school year 2011/2012.

During the 2011-2012 school year the district plans to use carried over funds in two ways.

1. Due to declining enrolment the school district is challenged to provide a quality French instruction. This is due to small class sizes and the availability of teachers qualified to teach to French. In the 2011-2012 school year a teacher will be provided with the necessary training, time and preparation to provide a quality secondary French program via our Shared Learning program to all secondary schools.
2. To support the interest and engagement in a French program the district is planning a trip to Quebec for interested secondary students.
