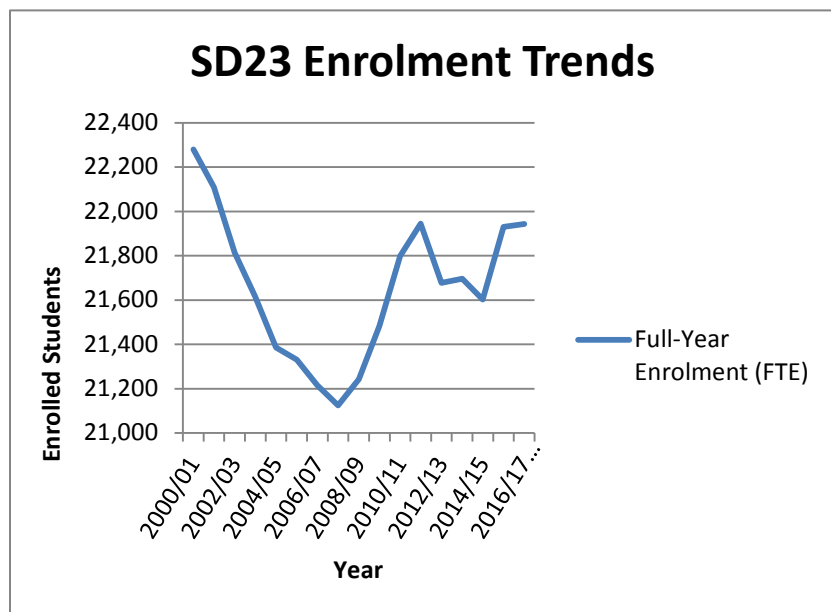

## Total Capital Investment

Since 2001, the Province has invested \$114.1M in the Central Okanagan School District to complete 15 construction projects, including recent additions to Rutland Senior Secondary, Mount Boucherie Senior Secondary and Okanagan Mission Secondary; replacement of Dr. Knox Middle School; and the new Chute Lake Elementary and Mar Jok Elementary, and just recently nine School Enhancement Program projects. Also in this time, 3100 student spaces have been added.
