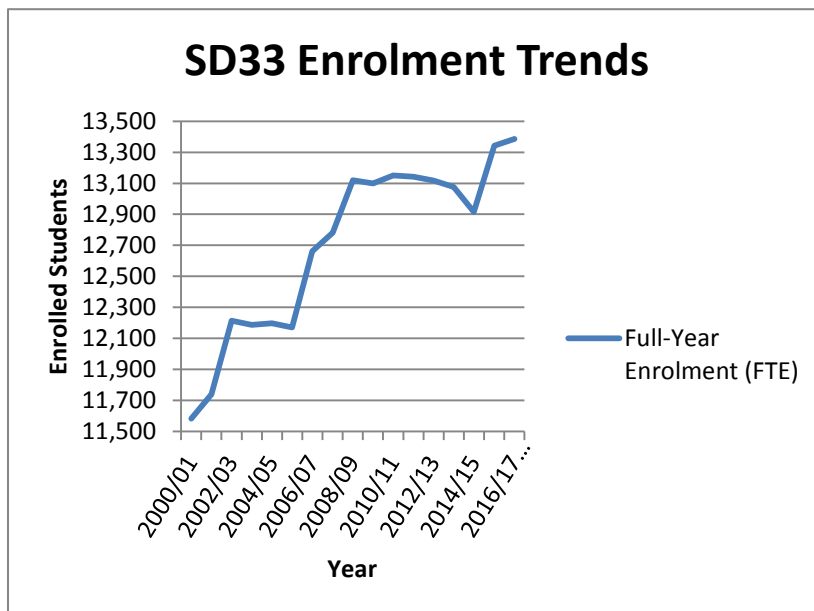
### Class Size

## Total Capital Investment

Since 2001, the Province has invested \$148.2M in the Chilliwack School District, to complete 12 capital and seismic projects including the replacement of Greendale Elementary, Chilliwack Secondary, and the new G.W. Graham Middle-Secondary schools, and most recently five School Enhancement Program projects. Also in this time, 1,415 additional student spaces have been added to SD33.
