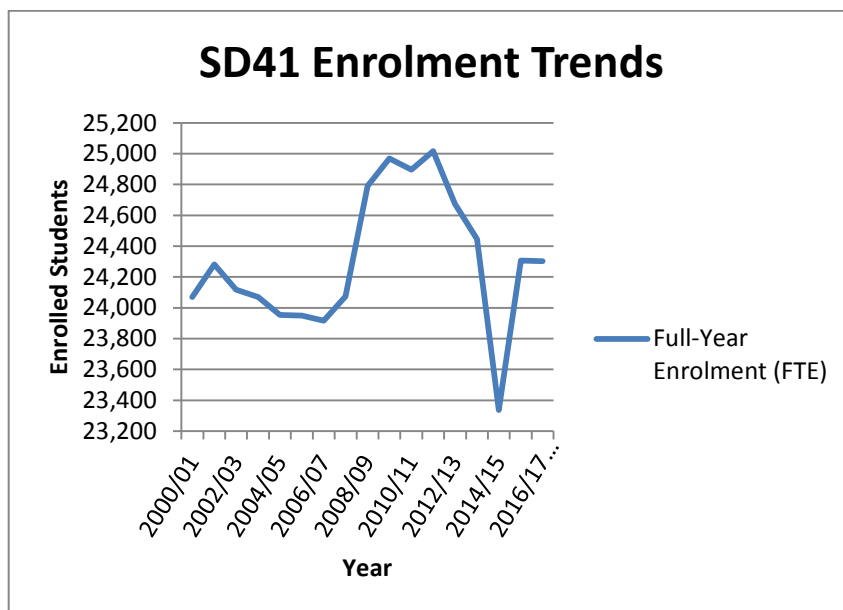

Since 2001, the Province has invested \$193.3M to complete nine capital and 8 Seismic Mitigation Program projects, and five School Enhancement Program projects in the Burnaby School District. Also during this time, 3,550 additional student spaces have been added.
