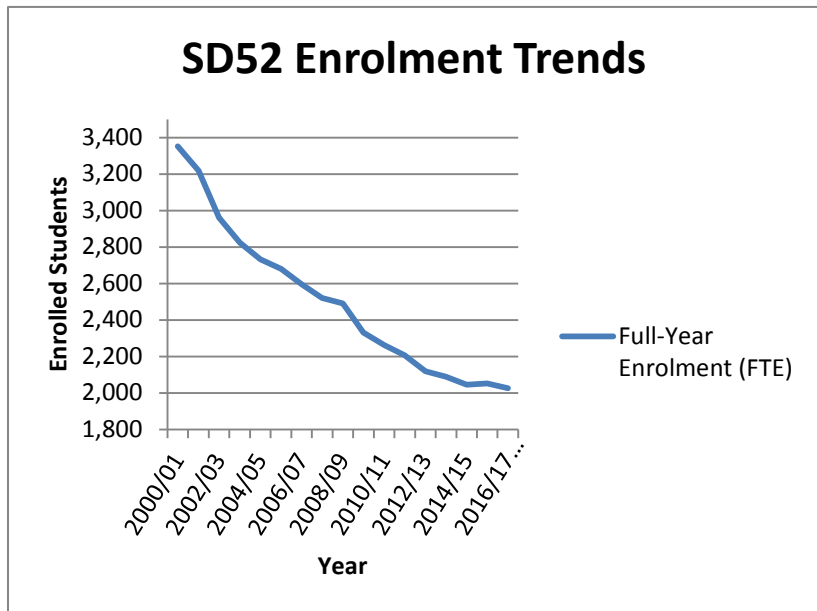
### Class Size

---

Since 2001, the Province has invested \$8.18M in the Prince Rupert School District for the new King Edward Elementary, the replacement of Port Edward Community School and most recently three School Enhancement Program projects. Also during this time, 275 additional student spaces have been added.
