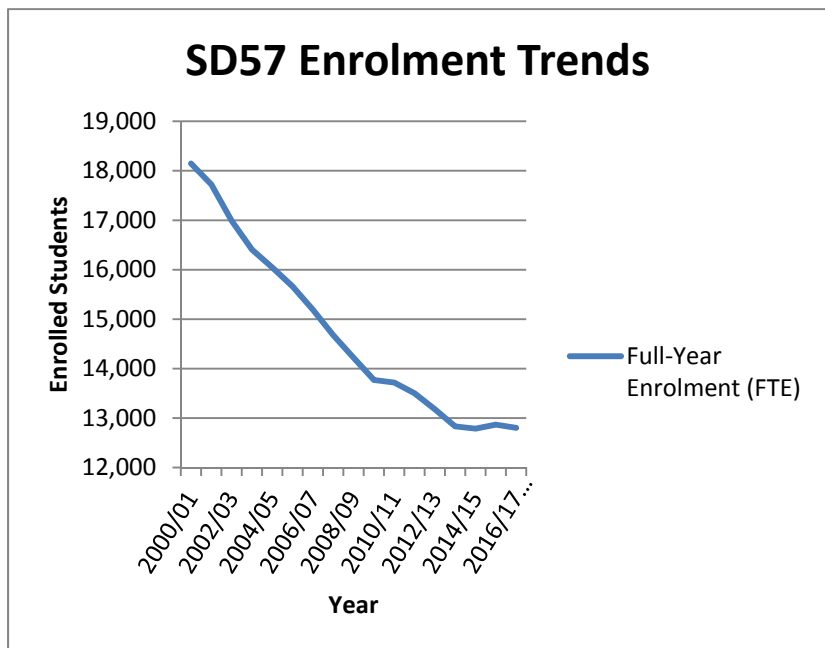
Class Size
