
#### **Class Size**

## **Total Capital Investment**

Since 2001, the Province has invested more than \$38.75M in the Nanaimo-Ladysmith School District for three capital projects including the new Cinnabar Elementary and additions to Ladysmith Secondary, Coal Tyee Elementary and Wellington Secondary, two Seismic Mitigation Program projects including Wellington Secondary, and also five School Enhancement Program projects. Also during this time, 1,850 additional student spaces have been added.
