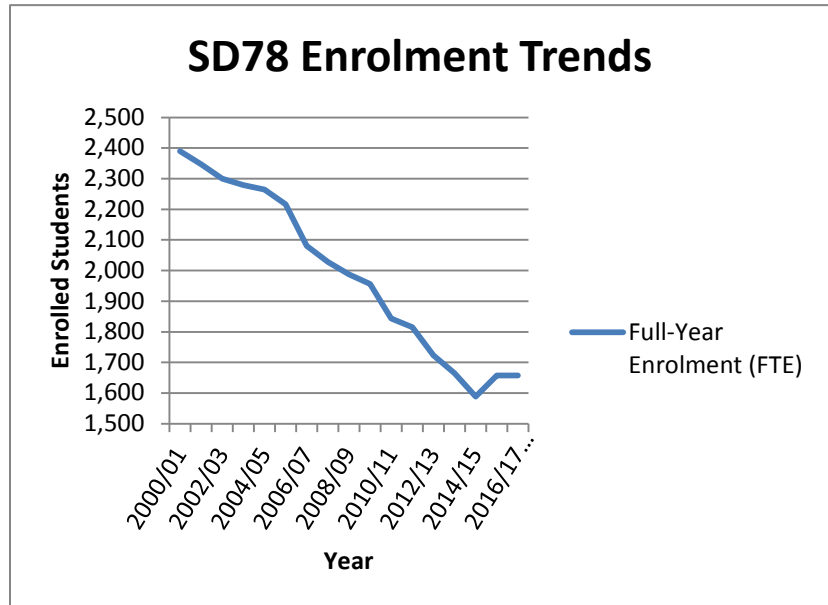
Class Size

Total Capital Investment

Since 2001, the Province has invested more than \$10.5M in the Fraser-Cascade School District for an addition and renovation at Hope Secondary and Agassiz Elementary/Secondary, a Seismic Mitigation Program upgrade at Hope Secondary and most recently, a Seismic Mitigation Program addition at Coquihalla Elementary. In addition, the Province invested more than \$394,000 for additional space for Full-Day Kindergarten.
