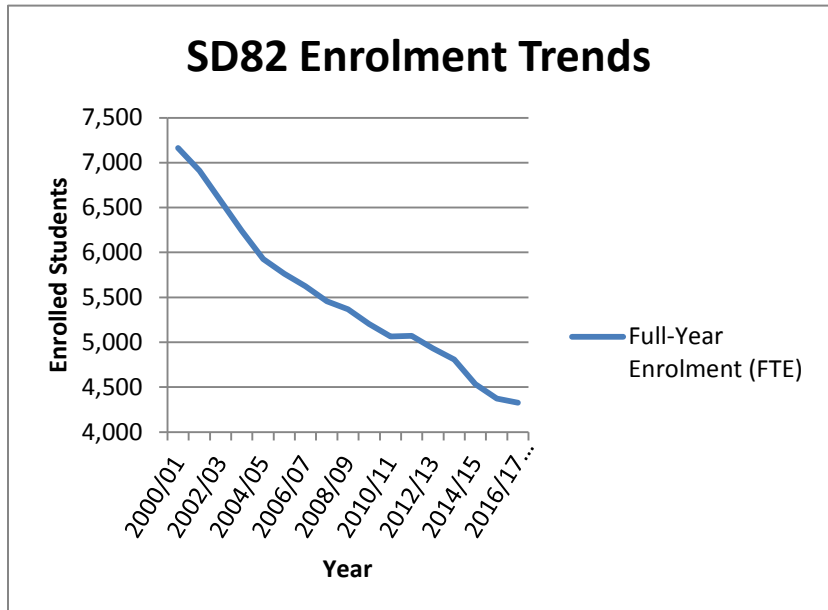
### Class Size

## Total Capital Investment

Since 2001, the Province has invested more than \$19.87M in the Coast Mountains School District, which included a new facility for Skeena Junior Secondary, and just recently two School Enhancement Program projects at Caledonia Secondary and New Hazelton Elementary. The Province has also invested \$90,000 for six classroom conversions for Full-Day Kindergarten.
