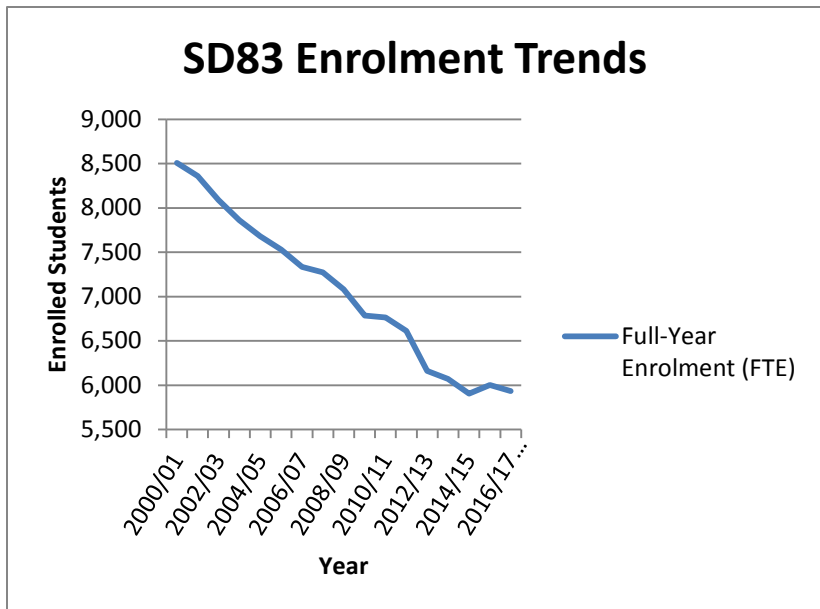
Class Size
