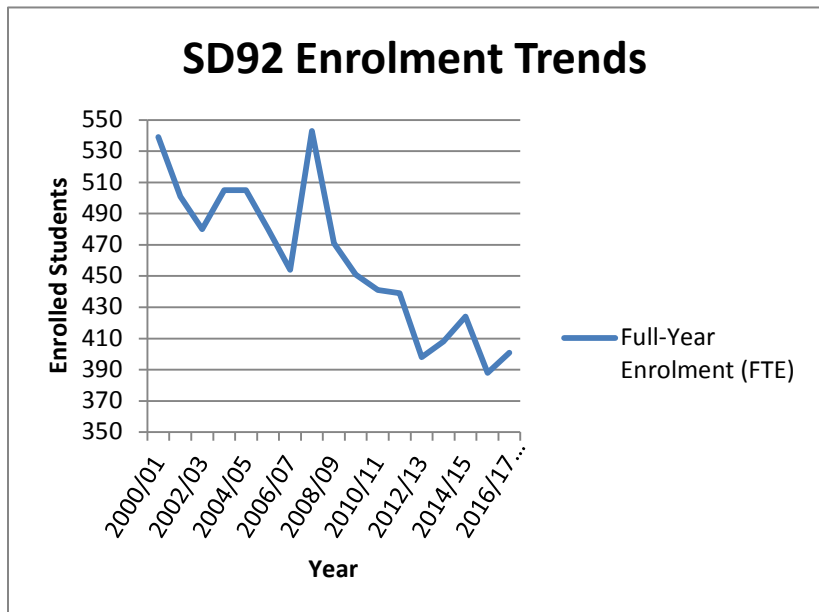
Class Size
