The licensee must take the original version of this application to the relevant local government/First Nation and request that they complete Part 5.

Eligibility: Liquor-primary licensed stadiums only

Policy: The general manager may permit liquor vendors (hawkers) in liquor-primary licensed stadiums provided the following conditions are met:

- Hawkets are not minors;
- Hawkets are not paid on a commission basis; and
- Hawkets may not sell shooters

In determining whether to permit liquor hawkers in the stadium and terms and conditions that may apply, the general manager will take into consideration the compliance history of the licensed establishment and the comments of the local government or First Nation.
