



GROCERY STORE DECLARATION

Liquor Control and Licensing Form LCLB090

INSTRUCTIONS:

Owners of eligible grocery stores must complete this form when: 1) a Licensee Retail Store (LRS), Wine Store (WS), or BC Government Liquor Store (BCLS) applies to relocate to within the eligible grocery store, or 2) they intend to co-brand with a LRS or WS that they also own, regardless of the store locations.

Part 3: Declaration and Signature

- I declare this location qualifies as an eligible grocery store by meeting the following requirements defined as:
 - Primarily engaged in retailing a general line of foods, including canned, dry and frozen food, fresh fruits and vegetables, fresh and prepared meats, fish and poultry, dairy products, baked products and snack foods, and non-liquor beverages, intended for human consumption
 - At least 10,000 square feet, including storage
- I understand that to maintain eligibility as a grocery store, the requirements listed above must continue to be met
- I understand that continued eligibility as a grocery store must be demonstrated by having sales revenue from food and non-liquor beverages that
 - totals at least 70% of non-liquor sales
 - totals at least 50% of all sales, including liquor sales from a retailer located in the grocery store.
- I understand LCLB inspectors or delegates may at any time request business documents to confirm this location continues to be an eligible grocery store as defined above.
- I acknowledge that only one LRS, WS or BCLS may be located within the grocery store.

This form should be signed by an appropriate individual who has the authority to bind the grocery store. The Branch relies on the grocery store to ensure that the individual who signs this form is authorized to do so. Typically, an appropriate individual will be as follows:

- If the grocery store is an individual, the individual himself/herself
- If the grocery store is a corporation, a duly authorized signatory who will usually be an officer or, in some cases, a director
- If the grocery store is a general partnership, one of the partners
- If the grocery store is a limited partnership, the general partner of the partnership
- If the grocery store is a society, then a director or a senior manager (as defined in the *Societies Act*)

False declaration of valid interest is reason for the general manager to consider terminating the licence application and/or cancelling the licence.

The information requested on this form is collected by the Liquor Control and Licensing Branch under Section 26 (a) and (c) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and will be used for the purpose of liquor licensing and compliance and enforcement matters in accordance with the *Liquor Control and Licensing Act*.
