



APPENDIX 1

1 Section 7 of the Carbon Neutral Government Regulation, B.C. Reg. 392/2008, is repealed and the following substituted:

Emission offsets

- 7** (1) A public sector organization, other than the government, that is required to apply emission offsets in order to be carbon neutral must do so by requesting that the minister apply the emission offsets on behalf of the public sector organization.
- (2) If the government is required to apply emission offsets in order to be carbon neutral, the minister must apply the emission offsets on behalf of the government.
- (3) Subject to any directives of the Treasury Board, the minister may set the terms and conditions for the application of emission offsets on behalf of a public sector organization.

APPENDIX 2

- 1 *Section 1 (1) of the Emission Offsets Regulation, B.C. Reg. 393/2008, is amended by repealing the definition of "director" and substituting the following:*

"director" means the government employee designated in writing by the minister as director for the purposes of this regulation; .

- 2 *Sections 8 (b) and 10.1 (5) are amended by striking out "Pacific Carbon Trust" and substituting "government".*

- 3 *Section 9 (3) is repealed.*

- 4 *Section 10.1 (6) is amended*

(a) by adding "and" at the end of paragraph (a),

(b) by striking out ", and" at the end of paragraph (b) and substituting ".", and

(c) by repealing paragraph (c).
