

Amendments to the Forest and Range Agreement (the Agreement) between  
Upper Nicola Band and the Government of British Columbia dated  
February 10, 2005

**The Upper Nicola Band and the Government of British Columbia hereby  
agree to the amendments of section 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 of the Agreement.**

Sections 3.1.1 and 3.1.2 are amended to read as follows:

**3.1.1**


After the execution of this Agreement by the Parties, the Minister of Forests will invite the Upper Nicola Band to apply for a non-replaceable forest licence ("the Kamloops uplift licence opportunity") in accordance with Section 47.3 of the *Forest Act* to harvest a total of up to 36,751 cubic meters over a 2-year term in the Kamloops Timber Supply Area.

**3.1.2**

After the execution of this Agreement by the Parties, and after the Minister has determined that sufficient volume of timber is available for disposition to Upper Nicola Band as a result of the implementation of the *Forestry Revitalization Act*, the Minister will invite Upper Nicola Band to apply under section 47.3 of the *Forest Act* for a non-replaceable forest licence (the "Merritt licence opportunity") for a total of up to 47,004 cubic meters over a 5-year term in the Merritt Timber Supply Area and for a non-replaceable forest licence (the "Okanagan licence opportunity") for a total of up to 36,000 cubic meters over a 5-year term in the Okanagan Timber Supply Area.
