



Amnesty Period

January 9th - July 9th, 2017

Terms and Conditions

- During this six month amnesty period, you are allowed to possess the Schedule 3 species you currently have **ONLY** for the purpose of shipping it to a jurisdiction that lawfully allows the possession of it, or turning it over to the Conservation Officer Service (without penalty).
- Any possession, breeding, shipping, or release that does not meet the conditions of this amnesty period will be investigated by the BC Conservation Officer Service and potential charges could result.
