The Province of B.C. needs deer, elk, and moose heads from animals hunted in the areas below to test for Chronic Wasting Disease and Bovine Tuberculosis!

Head drop-off (freezers) at these locations (during office hours only):

PEACE REGION

Peace Taxidermy, Hwy 29
Russell's Custom Meat Cutting, Chetwynd
Wildlife and COS Offices:
Fort St. John; and Fort Nelson.

KOOTENAY REGION

OKANAGAN REGION

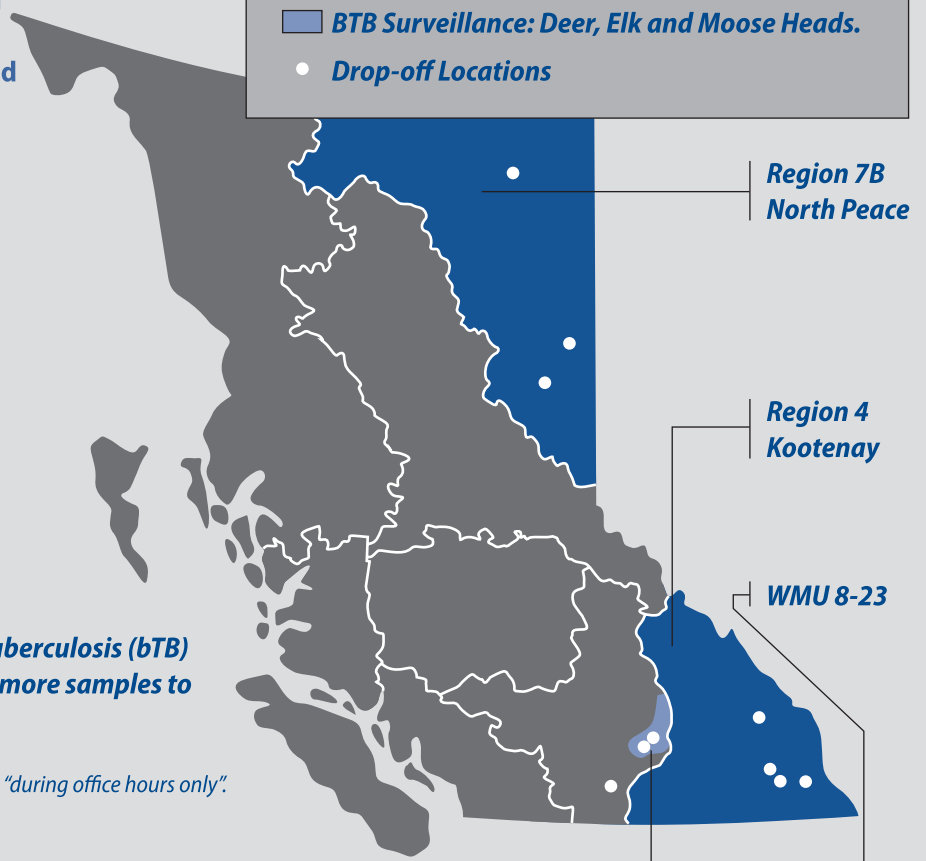

Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) and Bovine Tuberculosis (bTB) are not currently a concern, but we need a lot more samples to prove they are not present in B.C. wildlife.

The MOS and wildlife offices are only available for head-drop "during office hours only". Do not just leave the deer heads outside the office buildings.
