**CONDITIONS OF LICENCE**

1. No person shall purchase or otherwise obtain inedible egg product
  - a) for resale
  - b) in an amount exceeding 10 kg in any one calendar month without a licence from the Minister
2. An application for a Licence to Purchase Inedible Egg Product shall be accompanied by the fee provided in the schedule.
3. A Licence to Purchase Inedible Egg Product
  - a) is not transferable
  - b) remains in force until the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December next following the date of issue, unless sooner cancelled, suspended, or surrendered
4. The holder of a Licence to Purchase Inedible Egg Product shall furnish, on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month, a statement to the District Supervisor, Poultry Division, Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, showing:
  - a) the quantity of inedible egg product purchased or otherwise obtained during the previous calendar month
  - b) the names and addresses of the persons from whom the inedible egg product was purchased or otherwise obtained, and the dates of purchasing or otherwise obtaining the inedible egg product
  - c) the purpose for which the inedible egg product was purchased or otherwise obtained
5. No person shall purchase or sell or offer for sale inedible egg product for use as food, or in the preparation of food, for human consumption.
