It is very good that the Canadians are going to harmonize exactly with the US EISA regulations and also that they are making their effective date after ours instead of earlier. Since they haven't formulated their compliance plan yet, it probably will be the same as how they handled their E pact equivalent motors, ie CSA comes in and has random motors efficiency tested in the presence of a CSA field inspector.

Note, there is no mention of regulations for small motors in this proposal.
