The following recent upgrades have been made to the ECAS application:

Category 1 - Fixes & business validation refinements

ECAS32 and ECAS62	Proper transfer to GAS for FTA flag
ECAS40	When total length of Road is left blank, processing is continued instead of resulting in unrecoverable error
