

Coordinates - From Map to Field

To determine the coordinate of a point on the map and input it as a waypoint in your GPS unit.

Instructions

Step 1

Go to the Mineral Titles Online (MTO) web page at www.mtonline.gov.bc.ca

Step 2

Open a map viewer by clicking on either the **Mineral Map** or **Placer Map** depending on type of tenure desired.

Step 3

Navigate to the area of interest.

Navigation Methods:

1. **Zoom Tools:** Zoom in, Zoom out. The mouse wheel will also zoom the user in and out. *Tip:* Hold down the shift key on the keyboard and draw a box on the map where you would like to zoom to.



2. Clicking on the **Find Mineral Titles** or **Find Cell** link on the right hand frame of the Map Viewer will take you to the geographic location of the found title or cell.

3. **Find Location tool**

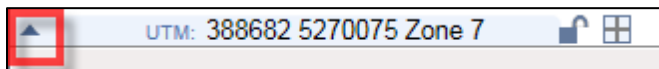


Step 4

Zoom in relatively close to your point of interest.

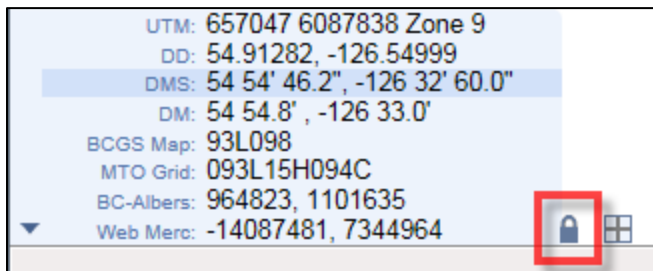
Step 5

Click on the up arrow on the coordinate readout bar to expand the view.



Step 6

Click on the open **lock symbol** to lock the coordinate readout.



Step 7

Click on the map to return the coordinates for that location.

Step 8

If you wish to copy these coordinates, simply click into the coordinate readout window and drag to **highlight** the text you wish to copy. Either right-click and select **copy** from the menu, or use **CNTL-C**, to copy.

Paste the information into the desired location.

Step 7

You can now take these coordinates and input them into your GPS unit as a waypoint.

Step 8

Repeat Steps 3 to 7 for each point you wish to retrieve coordinates.

Step 9

Close map window when done.
