ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Canlava Mining Corporation, the recorded holders of mineral claim title numbers 552589, 552591 – 552594 and 1041719 registered physical and technical exploration and development work pursuant to the mineral claims under Section 29 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act);

AND WHEREAS, Section 33(1) of the Act requires the recorded holder to submit a report in the form and manner prescribed by the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation (the Regulation) respecting this technical exploration and development;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the reduction of the work credits recorded on events 5561021, 5594150 and 5611358 based on the following:

- Section 16(3) of the Regulation requires that the report must be in the form and medium specified in Schedule A of the Regulation.
- Section 16(5) of the Regulation states that if the recorded holder fails to submit a report, as required under section 16(3) of the Regulation, the Chief Gold Commissioner may notify the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development under Section 33 of the Act.
- On July 3, 2015, March 8, 2016 and July 21, 2016, exploration and development work was registered and recorded as per Mineral Titles Online event numbers 5561021, 5594150 and 5611358.
- Physical and technical reports were submitted under Mineral Titles Online event numbers 5561021, 5594150 and 5611358 for the total applied work value of \$45,270.51.

- On December 29, 2016, you were advised by Mineral Titles staff that the report for Mineral Titles Online events 5561021, 5594150 and 5611358 had been approved for the total value of \$38,043.96.
- For these reasons, the value of work applied to mineral claims is reduced by \$7,226.55.
