ORDER OF THE CHIEF GOLD COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, Jack Denny, the recorded holder of mineral claims title numbers 1031372 and 1037568 registered technical exploration and development work pursuant to the mineral claims under Section 29 of the *Mineral Tenure Act* (the Act);

AND WHEREAS, Section 33(1) of the Act requires the recorded holder to submit a report in the form and manner prescribed by the Mineral Tenure Act Regulation (the Regulation) respecting this technical exploration and development;

AND WHEREAS notice was given to the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development if a report in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations was not submitted;

AND WHEREAS the recorded holder has not submitted a report in the form and manner as prescribed by the regulations;

I, Mark Messmer, Chief Gold Commissioner for the Province of British Columbia, order the cancellation of the work credits recorded on events 5608413 and 5630203 based on the following:

- Section 16(3) of the Regulation requires that the report must be in the form and medium specified in Schedule A of the Regulation.
- Section 16(5) of the Regulation states that if the recorded holder fails to submit a report, as required under section 16(3) of the Regulation, the Chief Gold Commissioner may notify the recorded holder of the intention to cancel the registration of the recording of exploration and development under Section 33 of the Act.

- On June 28, 2016, exploration and development work was registered and recorded as per Mineral Titles Online event number 5608413.
- On August 31, 2016, you were advised by letter that the submitted report was not in the form and manner prescribed by the regulations. You were provided 30 days to submit an amended report.
- On November 15, 2016, you were advised by letter of the Chief Gold Commissioner's intention to cancel the registration of the recording of the exploration and development should the amended report not be submitted within 14 days of the date of the letter.
- On December 22, 2016, exploration and development work was registered and recorded as per Mineral Titles Online event number 5630203 and linked with event 5608413.
- To date, the amended report has not been amended.
