RECOMMEND THAT, pursuant to subsection (1) of section 15A of the "Placer-mining Act" as enacted by chapter 29 of the Statutes of British Columbia, 1944, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following described lands in the Omineca and Skeena Mining Divisions, namely:-

All and singular those lands and premises of lying upstream in the Tetachuck and Eutsuk Lakes drainage basin lying upstream from a point two miles below the outlet of Tetachuck Lake, and below an elevation of 2900 feet (assuming mean high water of Eutsuk Lake to be at elevation 2817 feet).

Also all that area in the Whitesail River drainage basin lying upstream from a point where the Whitesail River enters Sinclair Lake and below an elevation of 2900 feet (assuming mean high water of Whitesail Lake to be at elevation 2694 feet).

Also all that area surrounding Lindquist Lake (which drains into the westerly end of Whitesail Lake) lying below elevation 3000 feet, (assuming mean high water of Lindquist Lake to be at elevation 2900 feet).

Also an area one and a half miles wide extending from Whitesail River and Lake in the south to the Tahtsa River in the north and having one mile to the east and one half mile to the west of a straight line drawn from the outlet of Whitesail Lake true north to its intersection with the Tahtsa River.

Also an area one and a half miles wide in the Tahtsa River drainage basin, being three-quarters of a mile on either side of the Tahtsa River, commencing at its confluence with the Whitesail River, thence upstream to the outlet of Tahtsa Lake.

Also all that area surrounding Tahtsa Lake lying below an elevation of 2850 feet (assuming mean high water of Tahtsa Lake to be at elevation 2782 feet).

Also all that area surrounding Troitsa Lake below an elevation 3050 feet (assuming mean high water of Troitsa Lake to be at elevation 2946 feet).

Also a strip two miles wide being one mile on either side of the centre line of Troitsa River from the outlet of Troitsa Lake to its confluence with the Tantsa River.

Also an area two miles wide being one mile on either side of a straight line drawn from the southerly extremity of Ear Lake to the northerly extremity of Ear Lake and produced northerly for three miles from the northerly extremity of the said Ear Lake.

Also an area two miles wide being one mile on either side of the following described line; commencing at the southerly extremity of Ear Lake thence in a southerly easterly direction in a straight line to the headwaters of Chatsquot Creek; thence down Chatsquot Creek to its confluence with the Kimsquit River; thence down the centre line of the Kimsquit River to a point six miles from high tide mark at the head of Dean Channel.

Also an area three miles wide being one and a half miles on either side of the centre line of Kimsquit River from a point six miles from high tide mark at the head of Dean Channel southerly to high tide mark at the head of Dean Channel.

Also an area extending one mile back from high tide mark along the easterly shore of Dean Channel commencing at the mouth of the Kimsquit River and terminating at the north boundaries of Lots 12 and 833, Range 3, Coast District (Reference Map 12A).

Also all that area more particularly described as follows: Commencing on the easterly shore of Dean Channel at the North West corner of Lot 12, Range 3, Coast District thence easterly along the north boundary of said Lot 12 to the North West corner of Lot 833, Range 3, Coast District easterly along the north boundary of said Lot 12 to the East corner thereof; thence due east (astronomic) for a distance of two miles; thence due south to an intersection with the North bank of Dean River; thence southerly to a point one mile distant from the said south bank of Dean River; thence westerly parallel to and distant one mile from the said south bank of Dean River to high tide mark on the shore of Dean Channel; thence northerly along said high tide mark to point of commencement.

AND THAT the undersigned Minister of Mines do sign an order to that effect, and that notice of the said order be published in one issue of the Gazette.
