The Lieutenant-Governor in Council: *conc. o/c 2564/55.*

The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to subsection (5) of section 14 of the "Mineral Act" as enacted by chapter 213 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1948, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following lands, namely:

All and singular those lands and premises in the Osoyoos Mining Division commencing at a point on the westerly boundary of Lot 2355-S, Similkameen Division of Yale Land District, a distance of 20 chains from the north-west corner thereof; thence due west to the easterly boundary of Lot 1458-S; thence southerly along the said easterly boundary and its production southerly a total distance of 35 chains; thence due east to the southerly production of the westerly boundary of the aforesaid Lot 2355-S; thence northerly to and along the said westerly boundary to the point of commencement, and containing 280 acres, more or less:

AND THAT the undersigned Minister of Mines do sign an Order to that effect, and that notice of the said Order be published in one issue of the Gazette:
