The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to Section 14(5) of the "Mineral Act", and Section 16(1) of the "Placer-mining Act", chapters 213 and 214 of the Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1948, respectively, a reservation be placed upon all minerals in the following areas in the Lillooet, Clinton and Cariboo Mining Divisions, namely:

All that portion of the Fraser River watershed adjoining the said river and its tributaries and lying below the 1600 foot contour, bounded on the south by the northerly boundary and its production westerly of Lot 4682, Lillooet Land District, and on the north by the westerly boundary and its production northerly of Lot 9790, Cariboo District.
