Chanc. 9/c 188/70

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and the Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Similkameen Mining Division:-

All that part of the watershed of the main stream of the Similkameen River below the 3,000 foot contour of elevation lying upstream from the northerly boundary of Lot 53^S, Similkameen Division of Yale District, and the westerly prolongation thereof.

AND THAT when the title to existing mineral claims which lie within the above described lands is forfeited, the lands covered by such mineral claim shall become part of this prohibitory order.


