The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Liard Mining Division:

All that parcel or tract of land lying 3,000 feet either side of the line which commences at a point on the westerly boundary of Lot 6893, Cassiar District, a distance of 180 feet southerly from the North-west corner of GC 26 Fr. mineral claim, and extends a total distance of 41,200 feet on an astronomical bearing of south 82° west:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT upon the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease which lies within the area outlined above, the lands covered by any such mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.
