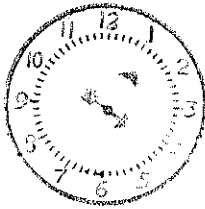

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following areas in the Carleton Place Mining Division:

Commencing at the intersection of the highwater mark on the left bank of the Firesteel River with the highwater mark on the right bank of the Sturdee River; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the triangulation station marking the summit of Thomas peak; thence in a general southwesterly direction along the height of land forming the easterly and southerly boundary of the watershed of the Firesteel River and Tatlatui Lake to the triangulation station marking the summit of Alma peak; thence in a general northerly direction along the height of land forming the westerly boundary of the watersheds of Hoy Lake, Trygve Lake, Kitchener Lake, and Stalk Lakes to the triangulation station marking the summit of Stalk peak; thence northeasterly, easterly and southeasterly along the height of land forming the northerly boundary of the watersheds of the Stalk Lakes, Kitchener Lake, and Rognaas Creek to the summit of Mount Rognaas; thence northeasterly along the height of land forming a common boundary between the easterly watershed of the Sturdee River and the westerly watershed of the Firesteel River to the intersection of a line drawn N 65° W from the aforesaid point of commencement; thence S 65° E to the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
