THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following areas in the Cariboo Land District, Cariboo Mining Division:

All that portion of the watershed of Wolverine River lying to the north of the northerly boundary of Bowron Lake Park:

All those portions of the watersheds of Betty Wandle Creek and Cariboo River lying to the east of the easterly boundary of Bowron Lake Park:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
