To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Victoria Mining Division, Seymour Land District:

That part of Block 252 more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the most northerly northeast corner of Block 480, Seymour Land District; thence due north 15 chains; thence due east 35 chains; thence due south 35 chains more or less to a point due east of an interior angle of said Block 480; thence west 35 chains more or less to said angle; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Block 480 to the aforesaid most northerly northeast corner thereof; being the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
