To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Atlin Mining Division, Cassiar Land District:

An area one mile on either side of the center line of the proposed road from Wynton Lake south to the British Columbia - Alaska border:

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above shall be entitled to any surface rights in and along the right-of-way to be used by the said highway nor where any area is used for a structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease as a result of the building of the said highway:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above or any person exploring, developing, mining or working in any way the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, shall be entitled to any claim for damage which may be caused by any construction, operation and maintenance of a highway or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease as a result of the building of the highway:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT upon the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease which lies within the area outlined

above, the lands covered by any such mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.
