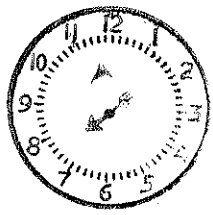

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 5698, being a point on the edge-of-the-bed of Haslam Lake; thence West along the North boundary of Lot 5698 to the northwest corner thereof; thence due West 10 chains; thence due North 3 chains; thence due West 8 chains; thence due North 5 chains more or less to the edge-of-the-bed of Haslam Lake; thence in a general easterly and southerly direction along the edge-of-the-bed to the point of commencement:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
