EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA -4 JUL 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Kamloops Mining Division, Kamloops Division of Yale Land District:

Commencing at the northwest corner of the Fractional East 1/2 of Section 20, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Fr. East 1/2 of Section 20, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian to the westerly boundary of Neskainlith Indian Reserve No. 1, being the natural boundary of Loakin Creek, on the left bank thereof; thence in a generally southerly direction along the said left bank of Loakin Creek to the intersection of the natural boundary of Niskonlith Lake, on the northerly shore thereof; thence in a generally westerly and southerly direction along the said natural boundary of Niskonlith Lake to the northerly boundary of Section 7, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary of Section 7, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian a distance of 7 chains; thence due north 15 chains; thence due west 5 chains; thence due north 5 chains; thence due west 10 chains; thence due north 22 chains more or less to the easterly limit of B.C.H. R/W Plan 1, Tube 1051, on file in the Department of Lands, Forests and Water Resources, Victoria; thence northeasterly along the said easterly limit of B.C.H. R/W Plan 1, Tube 1051, and the northeasterly extension thereof for a distance of 141 chains; thence due east 17 chains more or less to the westerly boundary of the southeast 1/2 of Section 29, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary of the southeast 1/2 of Section 29, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian, to the aforesaid northwest corner of the Fr. East 1/2 of Section 20, Township 21, Range 13, West of the 6th Meridian, being the point of commencement.

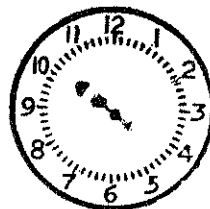
