EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 15 JUL 1974

Pursuant to the Coal Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that all coal in the following described area is hereby reserved from being prospected for taken or acquired:

Commencing at the most westerly northwest corner of Indian Reserve No. 6 (Ain), Queen Charlotte District; thence north 30° west 120 chains, more or less, to a point on the 200 ft. contour of elevation above sea level that surrounds Ian Lake; thence generally southwesterly, westerly, northeasterly and southerly around said contour to a point 136 chains north and 8 chains west of the said most westerly northwest corner of Indian Reserve No. 6; thence south 40° east 136 chains, more or less, to the shore of Massett Inlet; thence southwesterly along the natural boundary of said shore to the most easterly boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 6; thence northerly, westerly, southerly, and westerly around the boundary of said Indian Reserve No. 6 to the most westerly northwest corner thereof, that being the point of commencement.

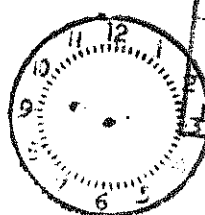
