EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 25. SEP. 1975

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

ADM

- (1) no person shall locate upon and no free miner shall stake on any of the lands within the area described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof which lands are situated in the Vancouver Mining Division, Group 1, New Westminster Land District;
- (2) upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in the right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall locate upon and no free miner shall stake on such lands;

and

- (3) with respect to the Placer Mining Act the lands described in Schedule "A" above are hereby designated as placer reserves.

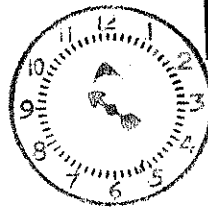
