Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Lieutenant-Governor~~ ^{Administrator}, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

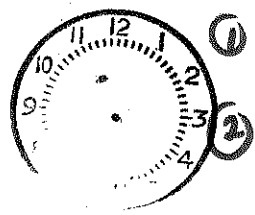
(1) no person shall locate upon and no Free Miner shall stake on any of the lands within the following described area in the Victoria Mining Division, Renfrew Land District:

commencing at the most southerly southwest corner of Block C of T.L. 44; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Block C of T.L. 44 a distance of 20 chains; thence due west 14 chains more or less to the natural boundary of Harris Creek on the left bank thereof; thence in a general southwesterly and southeasterly direction along the natural boundaries of Harris Creek and Hemmingsen Creek on the left banks thereof to a point due south of a point on the southerly boundary of aforesaid Block C of T.L. 44, said point being 5 chains east of the aforesaid most southerly southwest corner; thence north 12 chains more or less to said point; thence westerly along the said southerly boundary to the aforesaid most southerly southwest corner thereof, being the point of commencement;
