EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 24. MAR. 1977

*Am* Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) no person shall record or locate upon and no free miner shall stake on any of the lands within the following described area in the Liard Mining Division, Peace River Land District:

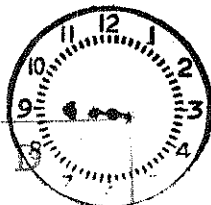
Commencing at a point on the southerly boundary of the watershed of MacDonald Creek, said point being the summit of Mount Saint Magnus; thence southerly in a straight line 4 000 metres more or less to the summit of Mount Saint Sepulchre; thence southerly in a straight line 4 000 metres more or less to the summit of Red Ridge Peak; thence westerly in a straight line 7 500 metres more or less to the summit of Constable Peak; thence northerly in a straight line 5 000 metres more or less to the summit of Hermitage Peak; thence northerly in a straight line 3 500 metres more or less to the summit of Sandhurst Peak; thence westerly in a straight line 5 000 metres more or less to the summit of Mount North Bastion; thence northerly in a straight line 9 000 metres more or less to triangulation station "IRK", (Elevation 2251 metres); thence North 45° East in a straight line 6 000 metres more or less to the westerly boundary of MacDonald Creek; thence southerly and easterly along the westerly and southerly boundaries of the watershed of MacDonald Creek to the summit of Mount Saint Magnus, being the point of commencement;

- (2) upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall record or locate upon and no free miner shall stake on such lands;

and

- (3) with respect to the Placer Mining Act the lands described above are hereby designated as placer reserves.
