EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- The following described lands in the Fort Steele mining division, Kootenay land district, are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

Commencing at a point on the westerly boundary of District Lot 227, said point being 1300 m northerly of the southwest corner of District Lot 227; thence due east to the easterly boundary of the aforementioned lot; thence in a general northerly direction along the easterly boundary of District Lot 227 to the southerly boundary of Highway Right-Of-Way, Plan 12655; thence westerly along the southerly boundary of Highway Right-Of-Way, Plan 12655 to the westerly boundary of District Lot 227; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of District Lot 227 to a point 1300 m northerly of the southwest corner of District Lot 227, being the point of commencement.

- No free miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
