EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA APR. 17, 1985

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. The following described lands in the Lillooet Mining Division, Lillooet Land District, are established as a Mineral Reserve and a Placer Mining Reserve until October 1, 1985:

Commencing at the point of intersection of 50° 35' parallel of north latitude with the 123° 30' meridian of west longitude; thence due south 1 925 metres; thence due west 2 700 metres; thence due north 930 metres; thence due east 900 metres; thence due north 960 metres; thence due east 1 800 metres, more or less, to the point of intersection of the 50° 35' parallel of north latitude with the 123° 30' meridian of west longitude, being the point of commencement.

2. No Free Miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
